Library continues free summer meal service for youth during Summer Adventure

Summer Adventure begins in June and one of the most important elements of the event is the summer meal service. Select Library locations will serve meals and snacks to children 18 and younger at no cost starting June 4. This program is sponsored by the USDA and Ohio Department of Education. Meals are provided in partnership with UMC Food Ministry and Mt. Healthy City Schools.
